Background

The Indian economy especially after the NDA came to power under the able leadership of Prime Minister Sri Narendra Modi, the insurance sector in the country has opened up to reach a new height. He encouraged foreign participation in a very big way to ensure competition, introduced many new insurance schemes/policies to bring benefits to all sections of our society. The government is making all out efforts to bring the rural people under various insurance cover. This will require a large number of qualified, motivated, efficient, dedicated and effective management personnel and service providers.

The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority (IRDA) of India have made the Licentiate Certificate, Associate ship and Fellowship mandatory for various jobs in the insurance sector-(both life and non-life).

The insurance coverage in the north-east region of the country is very poor. Even the awareness is negligible. The job in the insurance sector is a distant dream for the youths of the region and Assam is no exception. Many Assamese youths have developed a negative view about the sector and feel that insurance profession is not a cup of tea for them.

The Need

In view of the above, there is an urgent need to bring awareness among the people of the region in general and Assam in particular and motivate the

youths to prepare themselves for the competitive examinations as per IRDA requirements. On successful completion of the competitive examinations they will be eligible for the lucrative insurance sector jobs.

Objective

Keeping in mind the need identified, this training programme is structured with the following objectives–

- To bring awareness about the vast job opportunities in the insurance sector among the people of the region in general and Assam in particular
- To motivate the youths to enter into the insurance sector
 - To prepare the unemployed youths to fulfil the IRDA requirements
 - To impart necessary knowledge and skills to appear in the Competitive examinations
- To successfully enter the insurance sector jobs in various cadres.

Methodology

The programme consists of

- Classroom lectures
- Demonstrations
- Practice sessions
- Mock examinations
- Group discussions

All aspects of the programme will be handled by qualified, well experienced and skilled Resource persons.

For whom

The programme is primarily designed for the unemployed youths from Assam who possess competitive mindset, want to take up Insurance as their profession and have desire to join the insurance sector both corporate and private. However, there is no bar for others and sponsored candidates.

Qualification

The minimum educational qualification for the licentiate certificate course is HSLC or equivalent passed. As such, the present training programme is designed to acquire IRDA approved licentiate certificate issued by III, Mumbai.

However, there is no bar for youths with higher qualifications. Working knowledge of computer is essential.

Duration

The duration of the training programme for each batch – (3 Days in a week)

Fee

The fee for the entire 3-month training programme is Rs. 9000.00 (Nine thousand) only. Of this, Rs 7500.00 is payable at the time of Registration. The balance of Rs 1500.00 is payable to I.I.I examination fees. The fee includes examination fees, costs of books. The Institute will not be able to take responsibility for stay, accommodation etc. Outstation trainees will have to arrange of their own accommodation.

Place of Training

The entire programme will be conducted only at the Institute's premises at Bhangagarh and Rajghar Road Guwahati- 781005.

Training Schedule

Normally batch wise schedule during each calendar year is as follows:

First batch - Early March to May end- (Morning and Evening Shift
Time Schedule would be notified in due time)

Second batch - Early June to August end (Morning and Evening Shift Time
Schedule would be notified in due time)

Third batch - Mid September to December end (Morning and Evening Shift Time
Schedule would be notified in due time)

Per batch number of students is restricted to 50 only

Admission

Admission is open online for the year 2016. Eligible youths can register their names in any one of the batches according to their conveniences. The acceptance for registration shall be on First Come First Serve basis as there are limited seats. The acceptance or otherwise will be communicated online or

through mobile phones. Therefore, e-mail address and mobile phone are desirable.
